Dear Commissioner Adams:

With the beautiful restoration of the Roseland Community Center building, our organizations have a renewed interest in improving the aesthetics, amenities and habitat at the park, including removal of invasive plants which include Brazilian pepper, schefflera, carrotwood and air potato, all of which are non-native.

We thank you for your interest, and appreciation of the need for the County to do the heaviest/hardest part of this work. Doing so will help restore the park to a more manageable condition, allowing our groups and the community to commit to the new County "Adopt-a-Park" for this park. The shoreline is well buffered with mangroves and other native plants. Sprucing up the area and engaging volunteers from the community to help with maintaining the waterfront can provide a great demonstration for everyone who lives along the river as to what a functional, stable, living shoreline can look like.

A few folks from our groups recently visited the park to survey conditions and the extent of work needed. We've included a few photos taken from our visit, and you will note it appears there is an issue of a homeless person(s) occupying and being sheltered by some of the overgrowth. We ask that this be addressed by the County, as well.

Please advise as to when the County will be available to carry out this restoration work, so that our organizations may start the Adopt-a-Park process. If we can be of further assistance to help get this project started, please let us know.
