





BLUE-GREEN ALGAL BLOOM WEEKLY UPDATE




Satellite imagery provided by NOAA - Images are impacted by cloud cover.

A value of 0.004 is nominally equivalent to approximately 20-30 ug/L chlorophyll a of cyanobacteria, and 0.06 would be in the 300-500 ug/L chlorophyll a range. Please keep in mind that bloom potential is subject to change due to rapidly changing environmental conditions or satellite inconsistencies (i.e., wind, rain, temperature or stage).










Satellite imagery for the St. Lucie Estuary shows no significant bloom potential in visible portions of the estuary.



Satellite imagery for the St. Johns River shows no significant bloom potential on Lake George and on the mainstem of the river downstream of the lake. Doctors Lake was obscured by cloud cover in the 10/26 satellite imagery, but imagery from 10/27 shows low bloom potential on the lake.

SUMMARY

There were 18 reported site visits in the past seven days with 18 samples collected. Algal bloom conditions were observed by samplers at

On 10/17, the South Florida Water Management District performed two site visits. Dominant algal taxa and cyanotoxin results follow each waterbody name.

- Lake Monroe Center: Results pending.
- Lake Jesup Center: Results pending.

On 10/24-10/26, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) staff performed seven HAB response site visits.

- Jupiter Park Drive Canal: Merismopedia sp., no cyanotoxins detected.
- Caloosahatchee Santa Fe Canal: No dominant algal taxon, no cyanotoxins detected.
- Lochloosa Lake NE in veg: Microcystis aeruginosa, trace level (0.25 parts per billion [ppb]) microcystins detected.
- Lochloosa Lake Entrance to Cross Creek: Microcystis aeruginosa, no cyanotoxins detected.
- 183rd Ave Canal Off Cross Creek: No dominant algal taxon, no cyanotoxins detected.
- Lochloosa Lake at Park: No dominant algal taxon, trace level (0.25 ppb) microcystins detected.
- Violet Lake At 130 Violet Circle: No dominant algal taxon, trace level (0.27 ppb) microcystins detected.



Different types of blue-green algal bloom species can look different and have different impacts. However, regardless of species, many types of blue-green algae can produce toxins that can make you or your pets sick if swallowed or possibly cause skin and/or eye irritation due to contact. We advise staying out of water where algae is visibly present as specks or mats or where water is discolored pea-green, blue-green or brownish-red. Additionally, pets or livestock should not come into contact with algal bloom-impacted water or with algal bloom material or fish on the shoreline.

Janice Broda mentioned that the Heritage Center in Vero Beach used to do some outdoor movies in the evenings and thought they had been well attended. She didn't think that they do them anymore and suggested that I ought to reach out to see if they, in fact, aren't using the equipment and perhaps might be interested in selling it.


I spoke to Heather, the Executive Director at the Heritage Center and she said they only use the equipment a few times a year. It includes an inflatable rear-projection screen, sound equipment with two speakers, and the projector. Heather said it is pretty good equipment and thought that it is probably overkill for what they need – it was purchased before she went to work for them. There apparently is no current interest in selling the equipment but they do rent the equipment for \$450/event. She also pointed out there is a fee to show most films even if it is free event.


