Dear Mr. Keyes:

We are pleased to inform you that the Board on Geographic Names, at its December 8, 1988 meeting, approved the names Saint Sebastian River, North Prong Saint Sebastian River, and South Prong Saint Sebastian River. These names will be published in Decision List 8804 and the entries will read as follows:

Saint Sebastian River: stream, 3.2 km (2 mi.) long, heads at the junction of its North and South Prongs at 27°49'52" N, 80°30'25" W, flows NE to the Indian River, 4.3 km (2.7 mi.) NW of Sebastian; Brevard and Indian River Cos., Florida; sec. 24, T 30 S, R 38 E, Tallahassee Mer.; 27°51'16" N, 80°29'27" W; USGS map - Sebastian 1:24,000. Not: San Sebastian River, Sebastian Creek, Sebastian River.

North Prong Saint Sebastian River: stream, 4.7 km (2.9 mi.) long, heads at 27°51'28" N, 80°31'32" W, flows S to join the South Prong to form the Saint Sebastian River, 12.1 km (7.5 mi.) NE of Fellsmere; Brevard Co., Florida; 27°49'52" N, 80°30'25" W; USGS map - Fellsmere 1:24,000. Not: North Prong, Sebastian Creek.

South Prong Saint Sebastian River: stream, 13.5 km (8.4 mi.) long, heads at 27°44'56" N, 80°28'44" W, flows N to join the North Prong to form the Saint Sebastian River, 12.1 km (7.5 mi.) NE of Fellsmere; Brevard and Indian River Cos., Florida; 27°49'52" N, 80°30'25" W; USGS map - Fellsmere 1:24,000. Not: South Prong Sebastian Creek.
